BIBLE JEOPARDY!

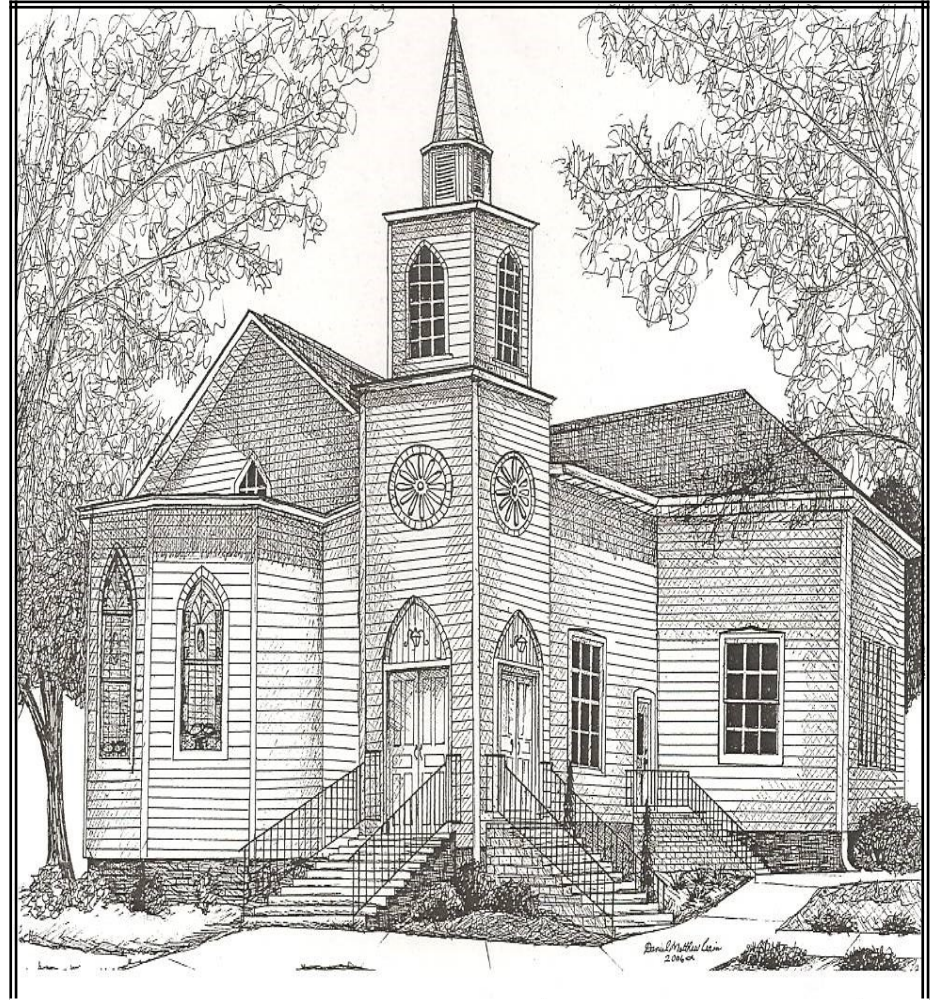
