### TODAY'S SERVICE

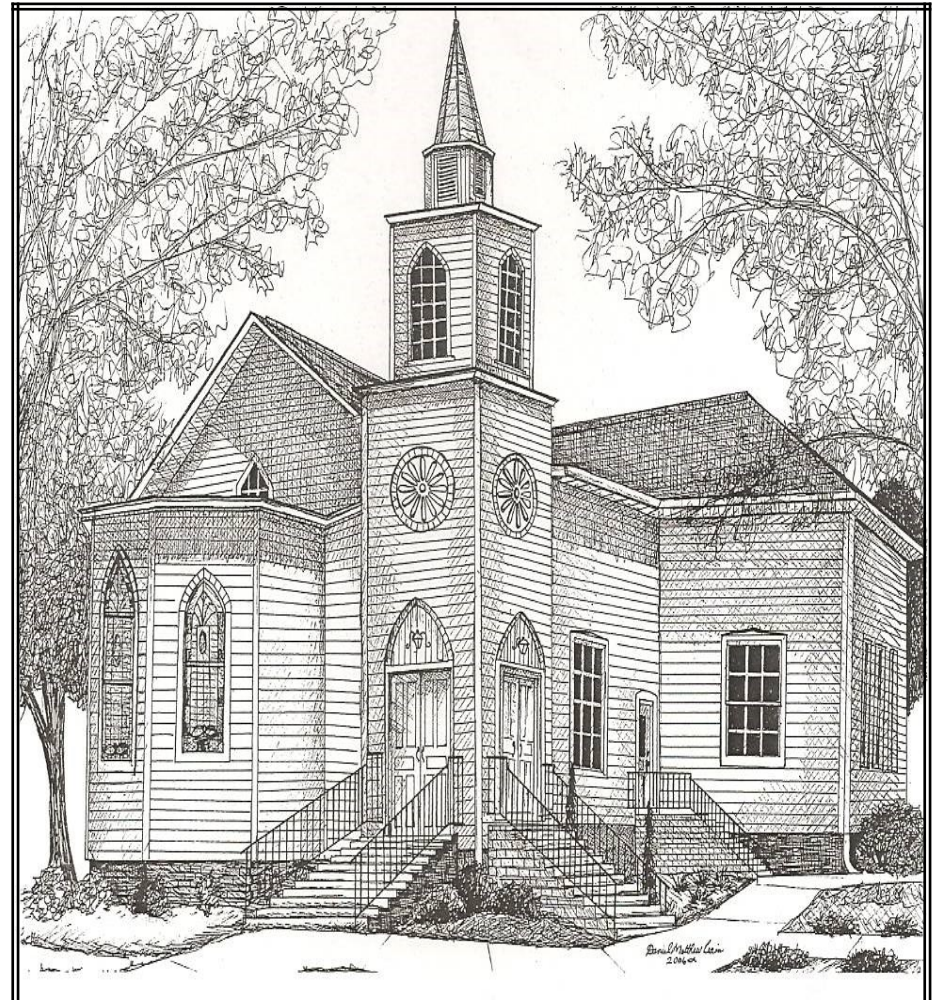
