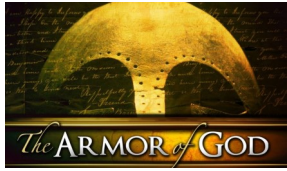


## IN OUR PRAYERS

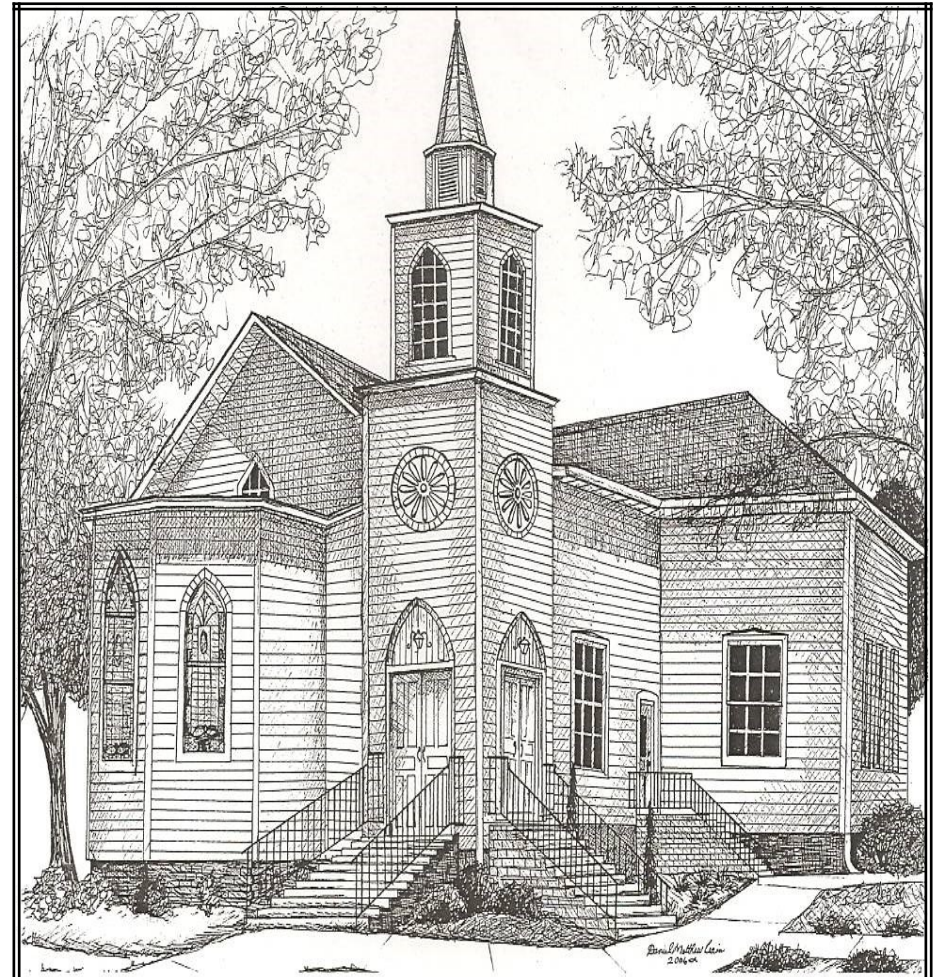
