## OFFICER NOMINATING FORMS

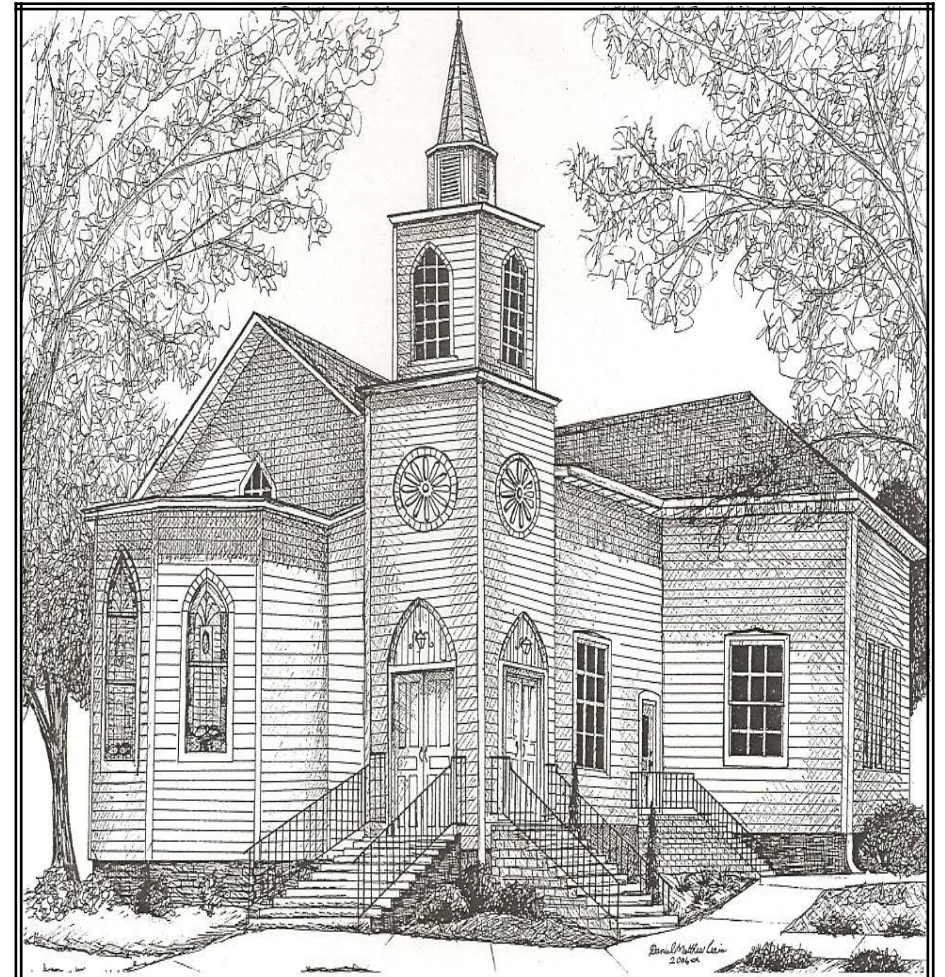
