In those forty days, and in that place, Jesus was faced with hunger, doubt and temptation.

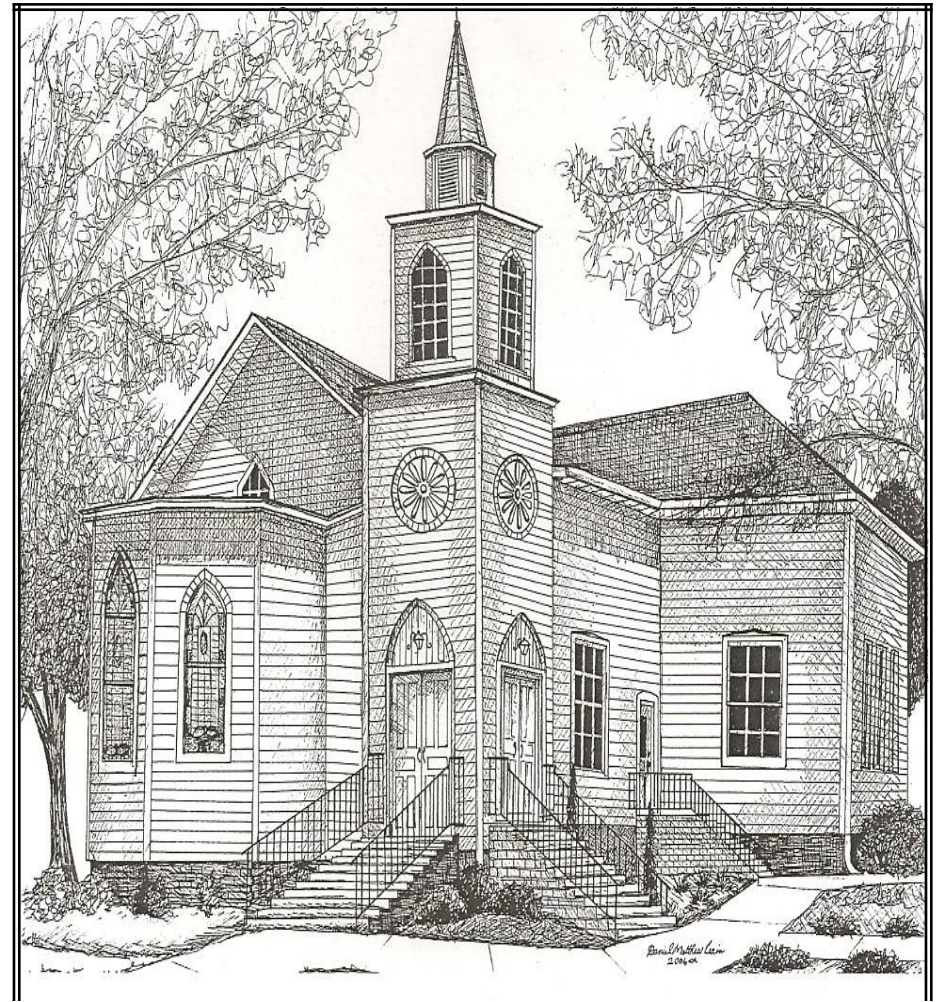
As we seek to follow Jesus, we would be led, even into the uncomfortable choices.
