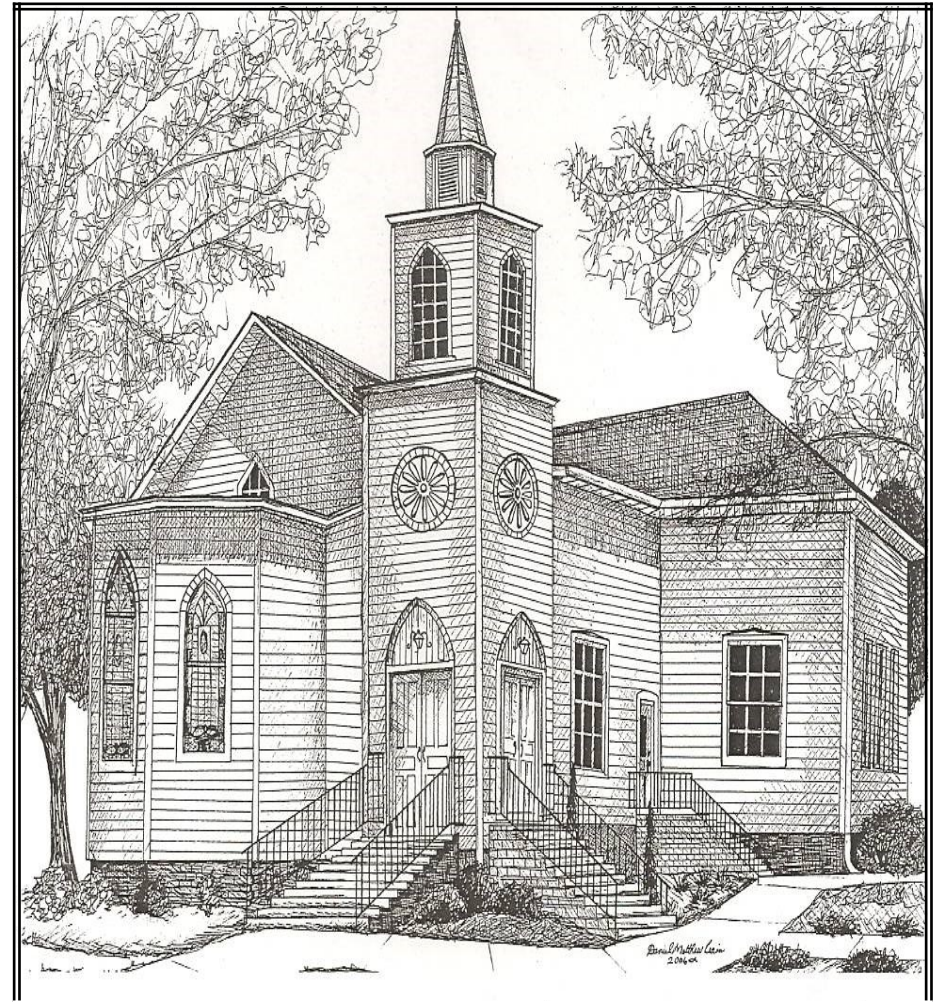
CONGRATULATIONS!
