HOMECOMING PLANS

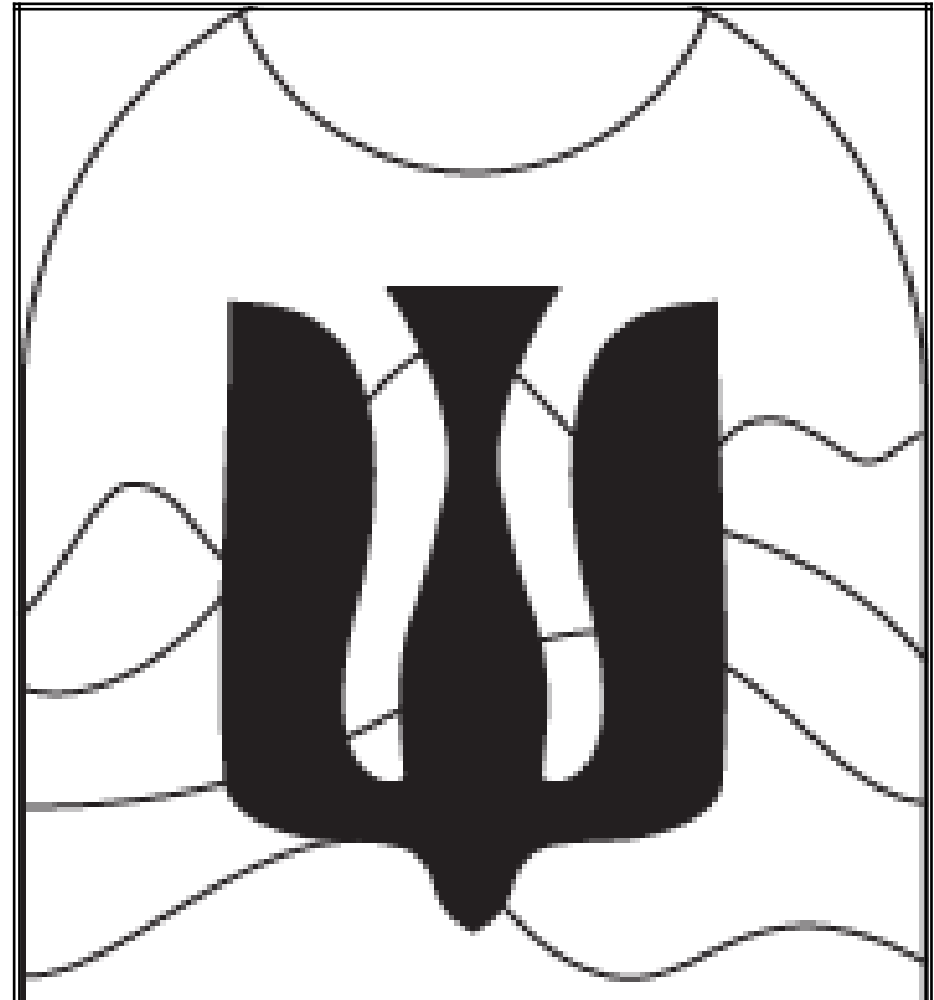
