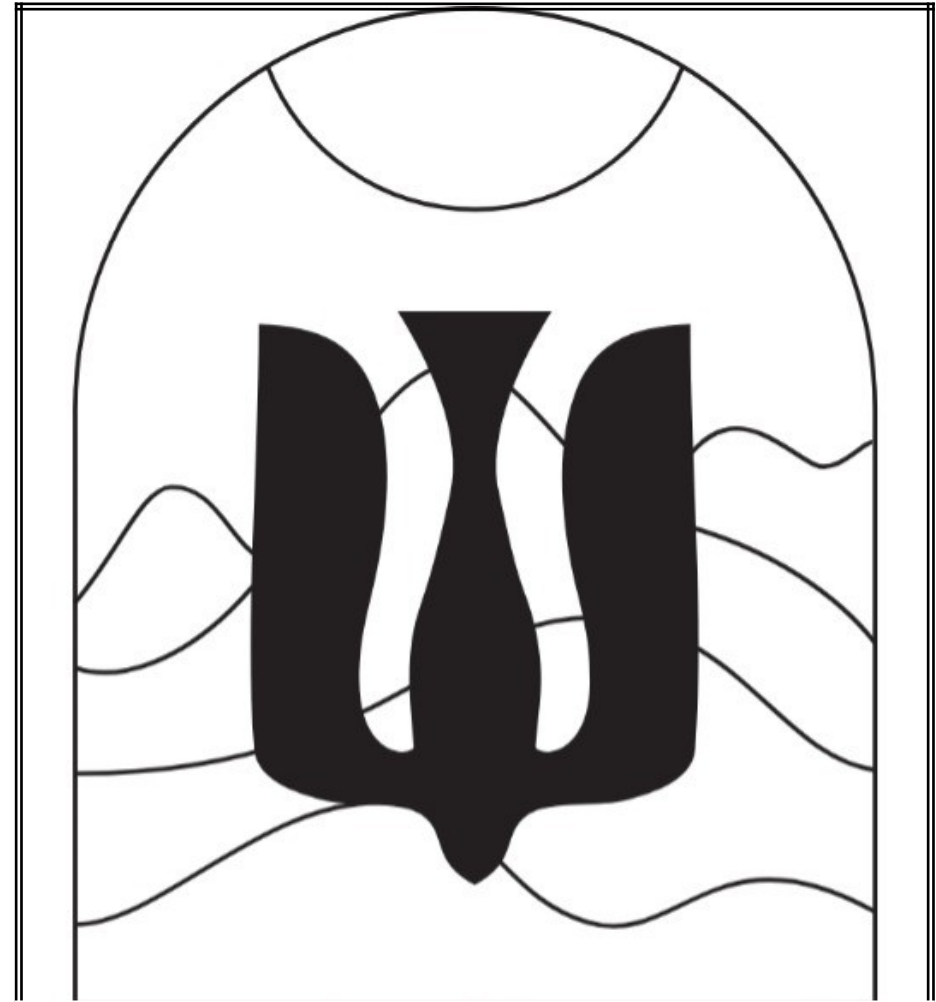
Memorials have been given in memory of Rev. Dale Burden by Nita and Robert McMillan and Sam and Edna Dillard.
