NOMINATIONS FOR NOMINATING COMMITTEE

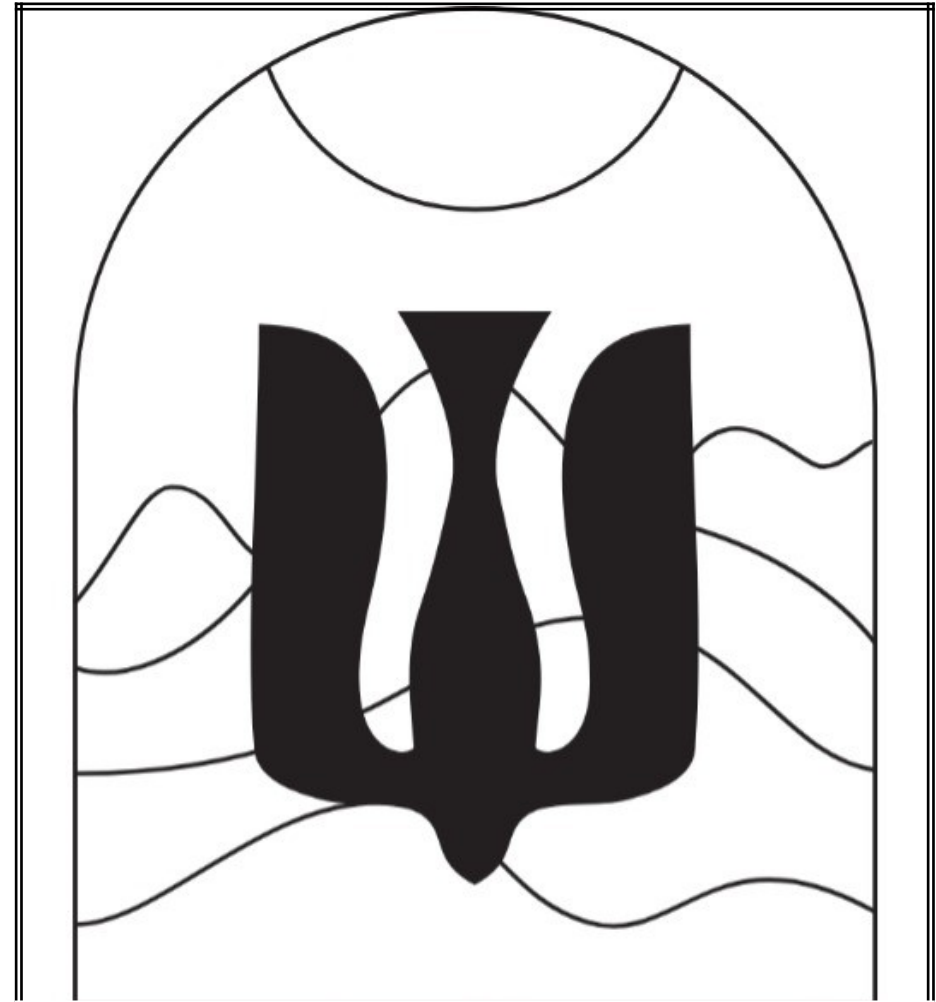
