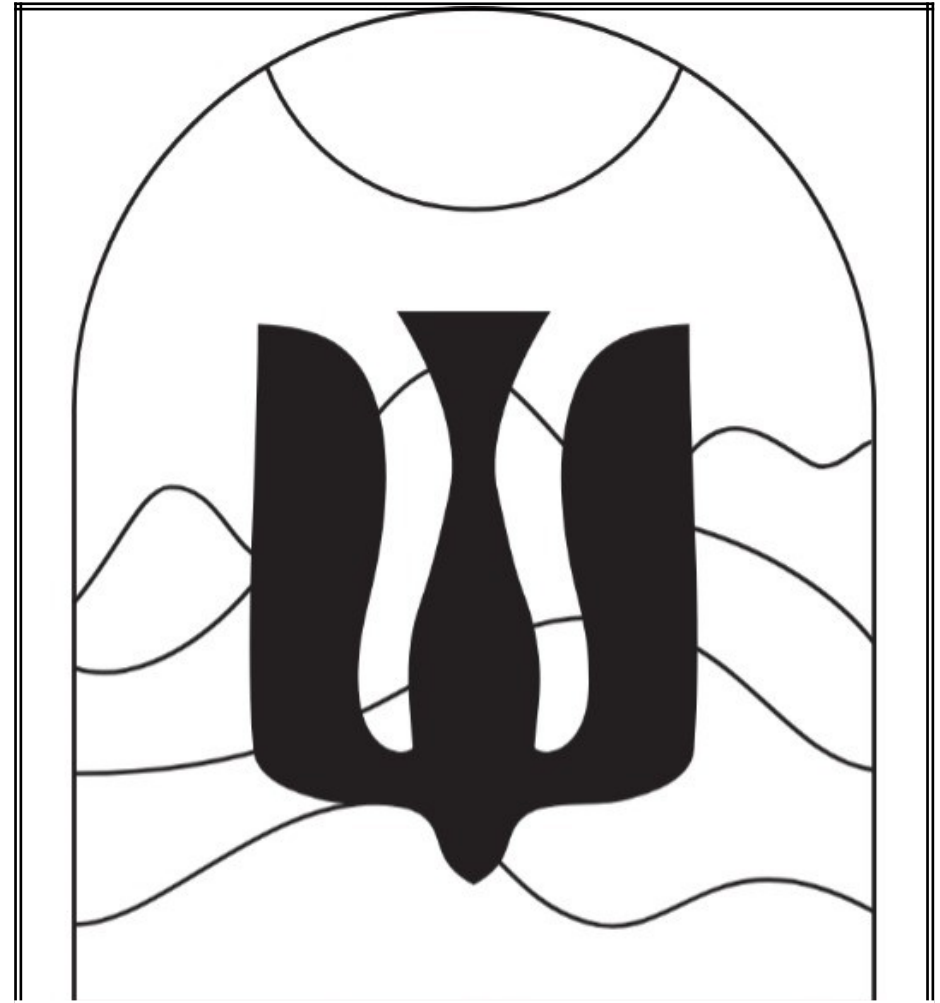
## SOUPER BOWL OF CARING
