### **HOLY WEEK SERVICES**

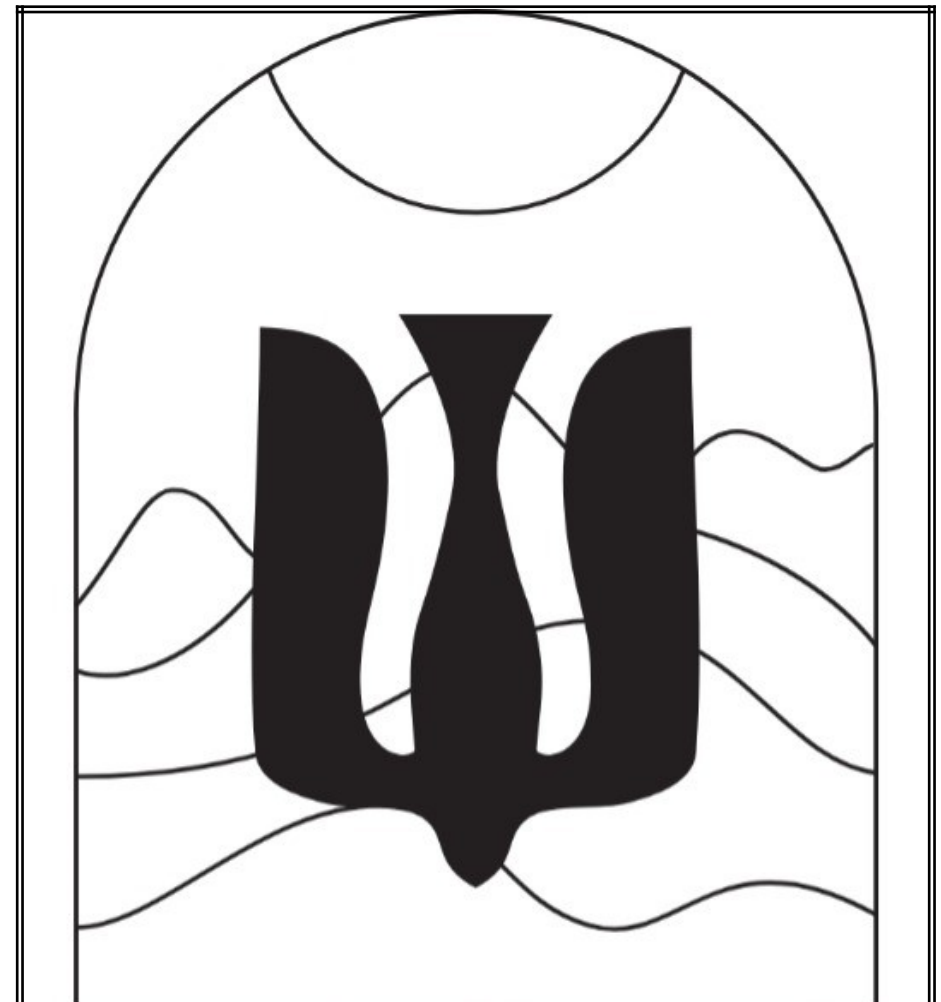
