## **EASTER SUNRISE SERVICE, BREAKFAST, EGG HUNT**

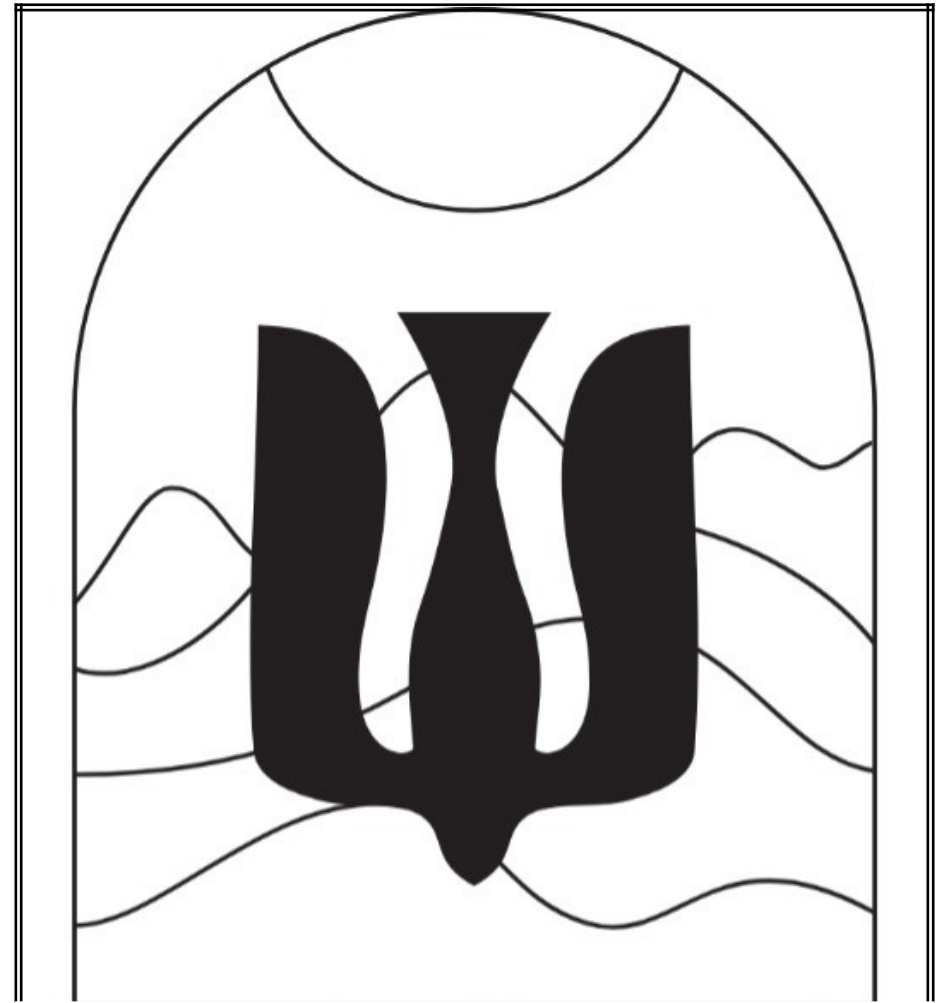
