RENOVATIONS

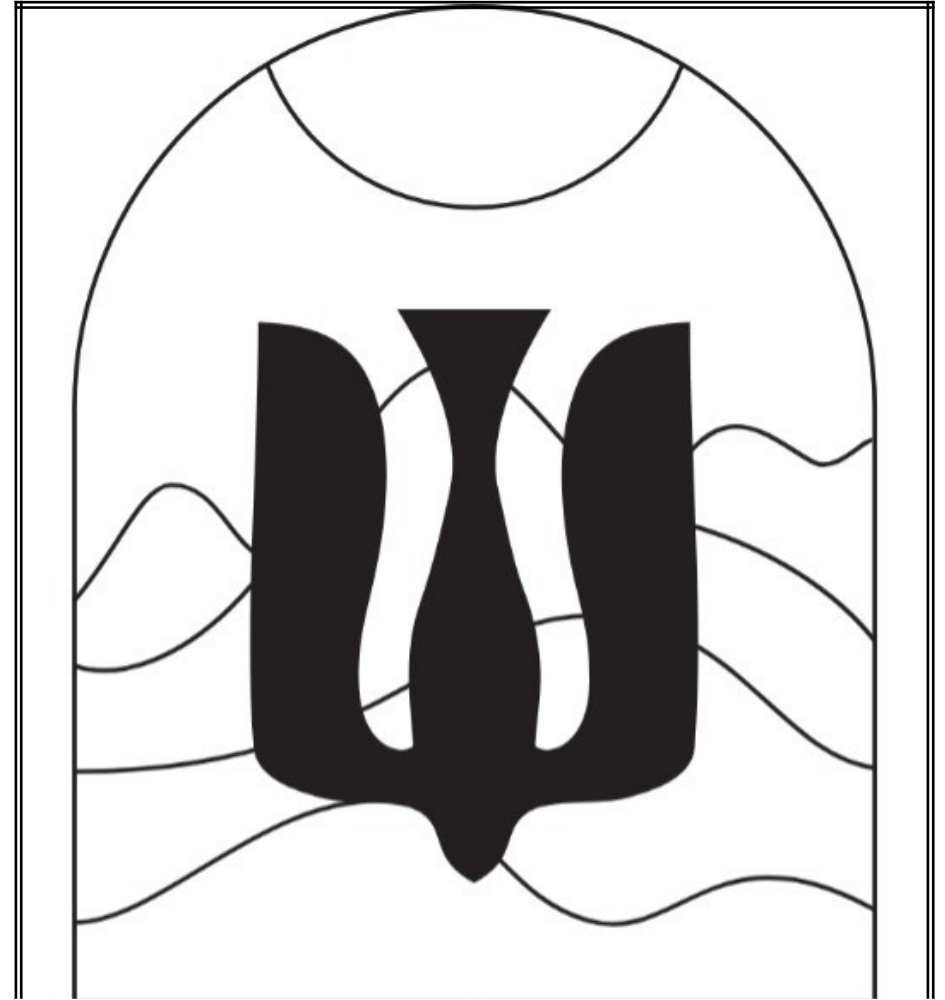
