EASTER EVENTS

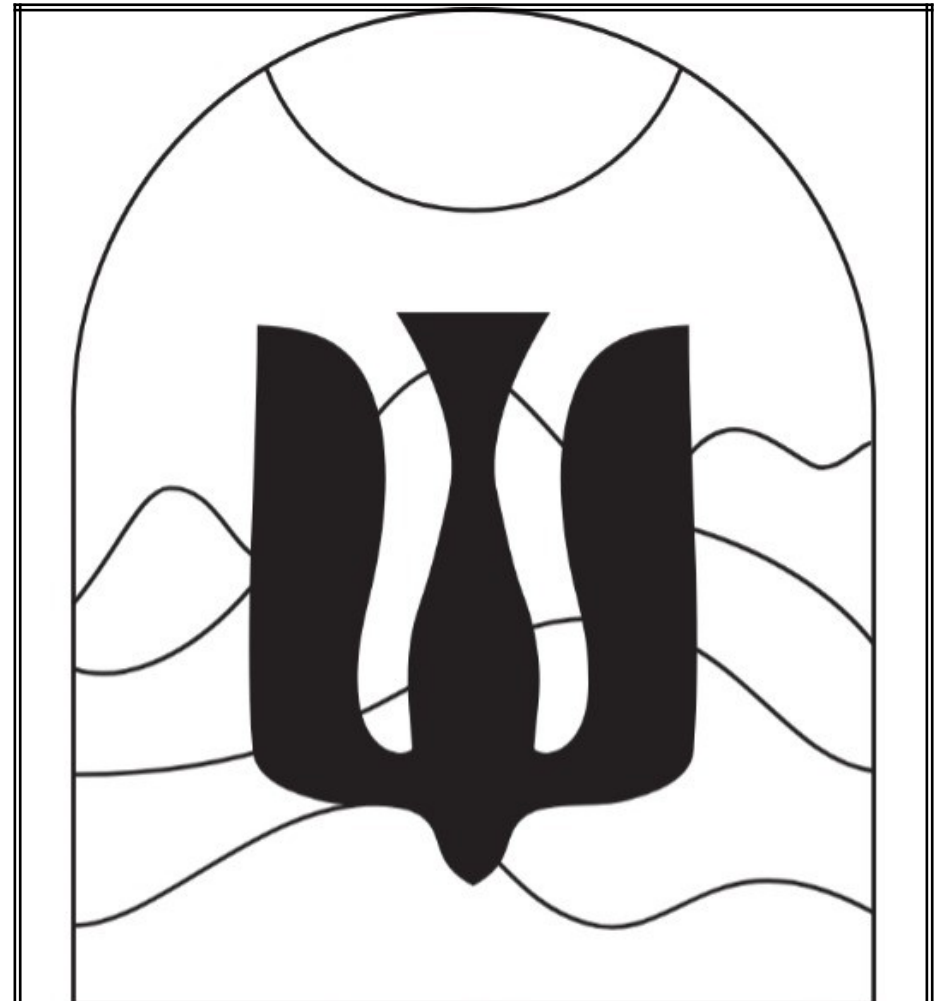
