PENTECOST OFFERING

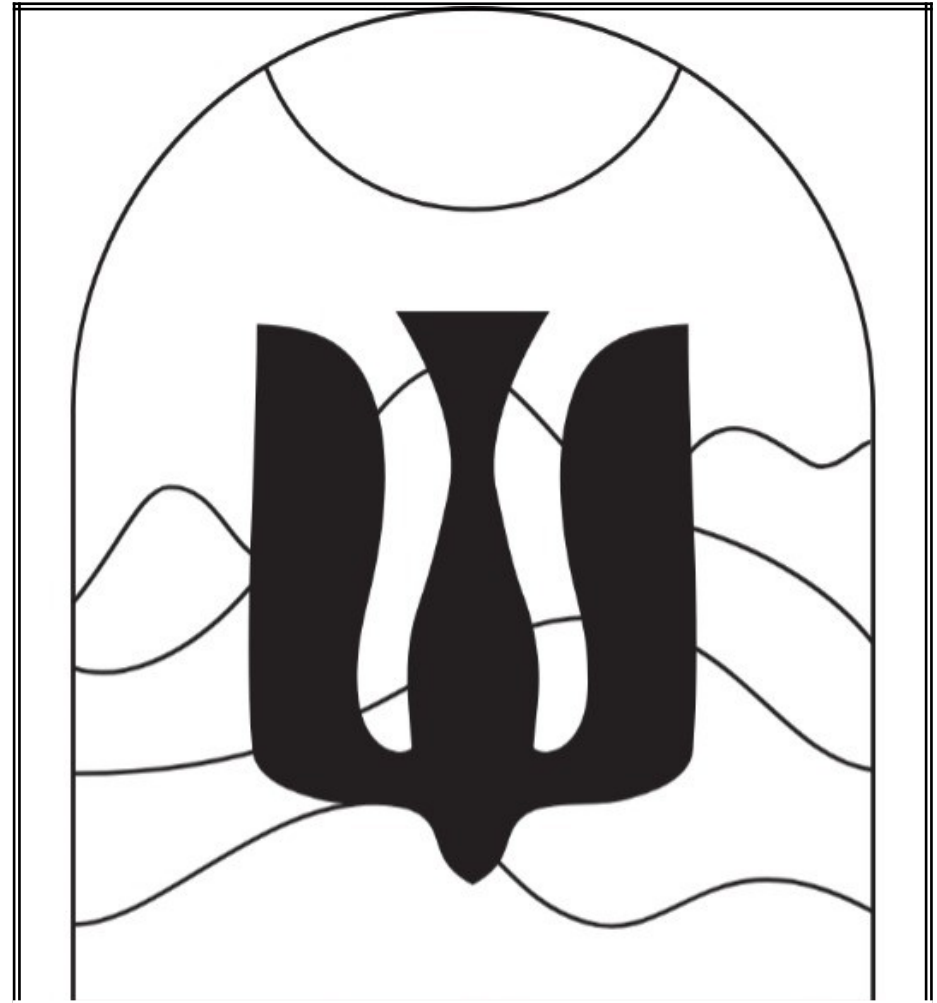


Today will be the last Sunday to contribute to our Pentecost Offering. Please be generous in your giving to this most worthwhile mission! God bless you!
