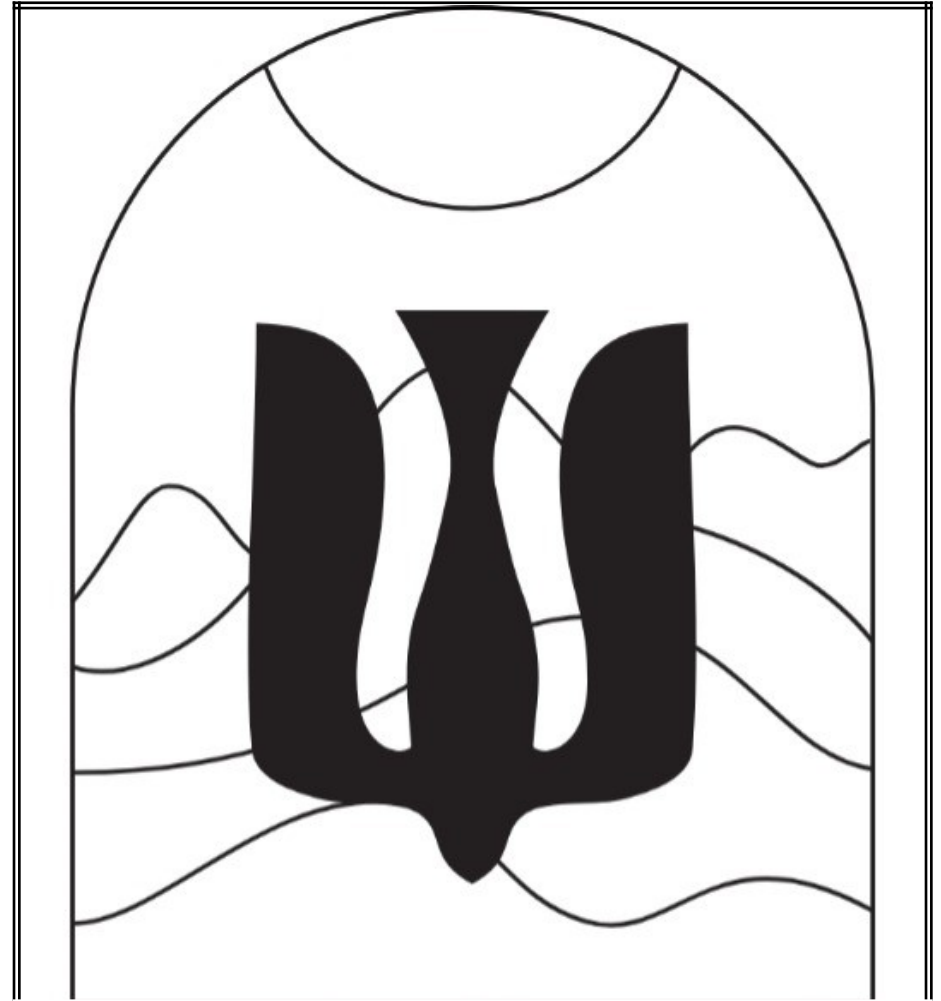
## PENTECOST OFFERING
