### **WORK DAY AT GOSSETT**

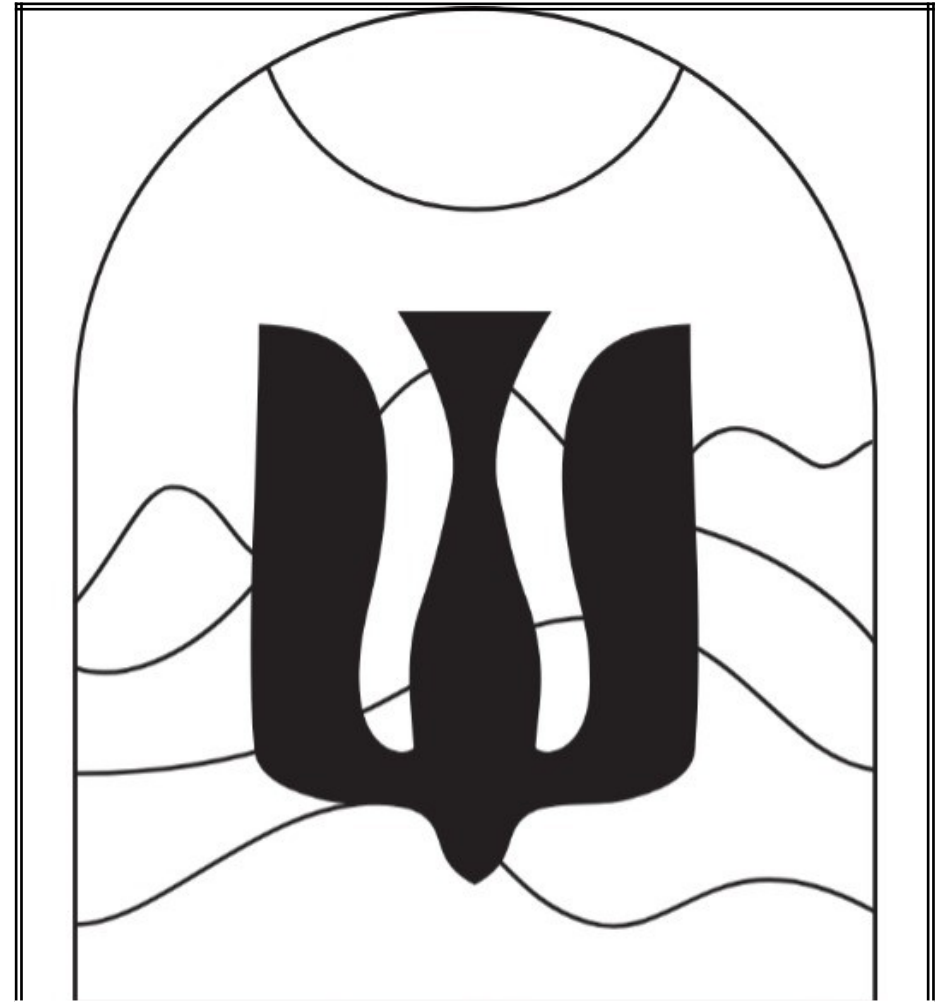
