PW CIRCLE

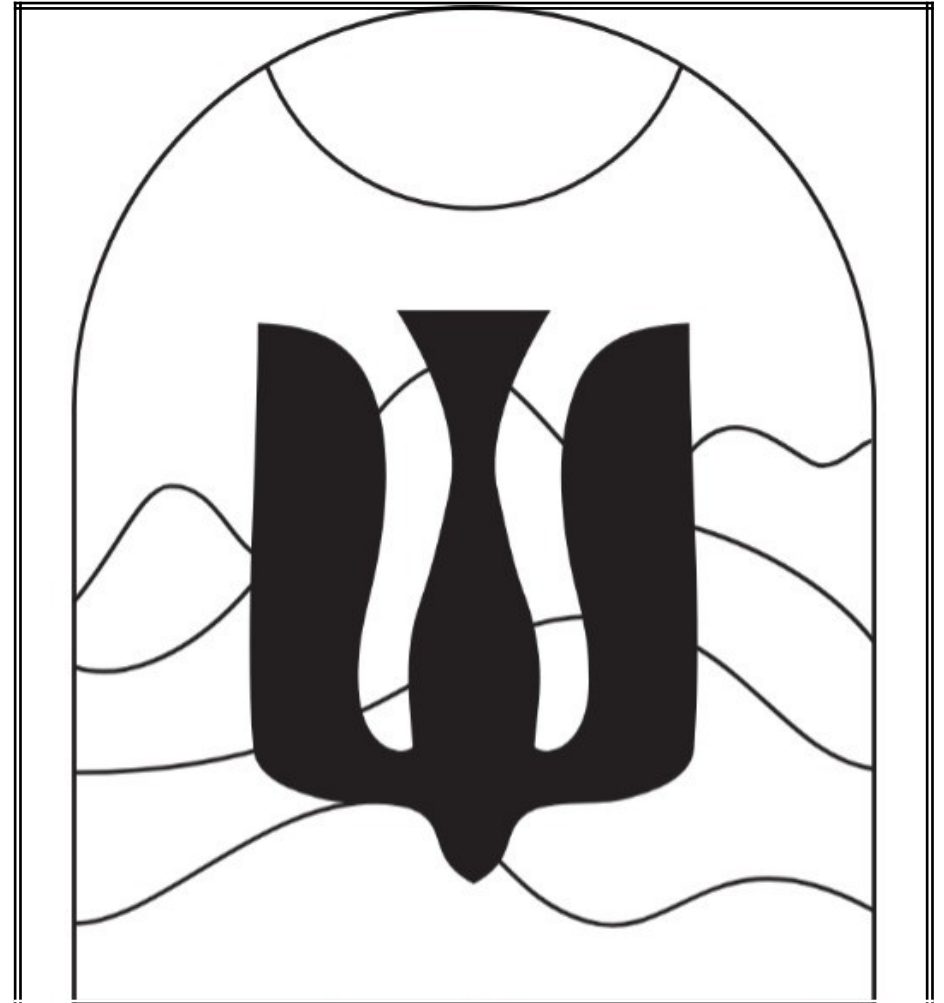
