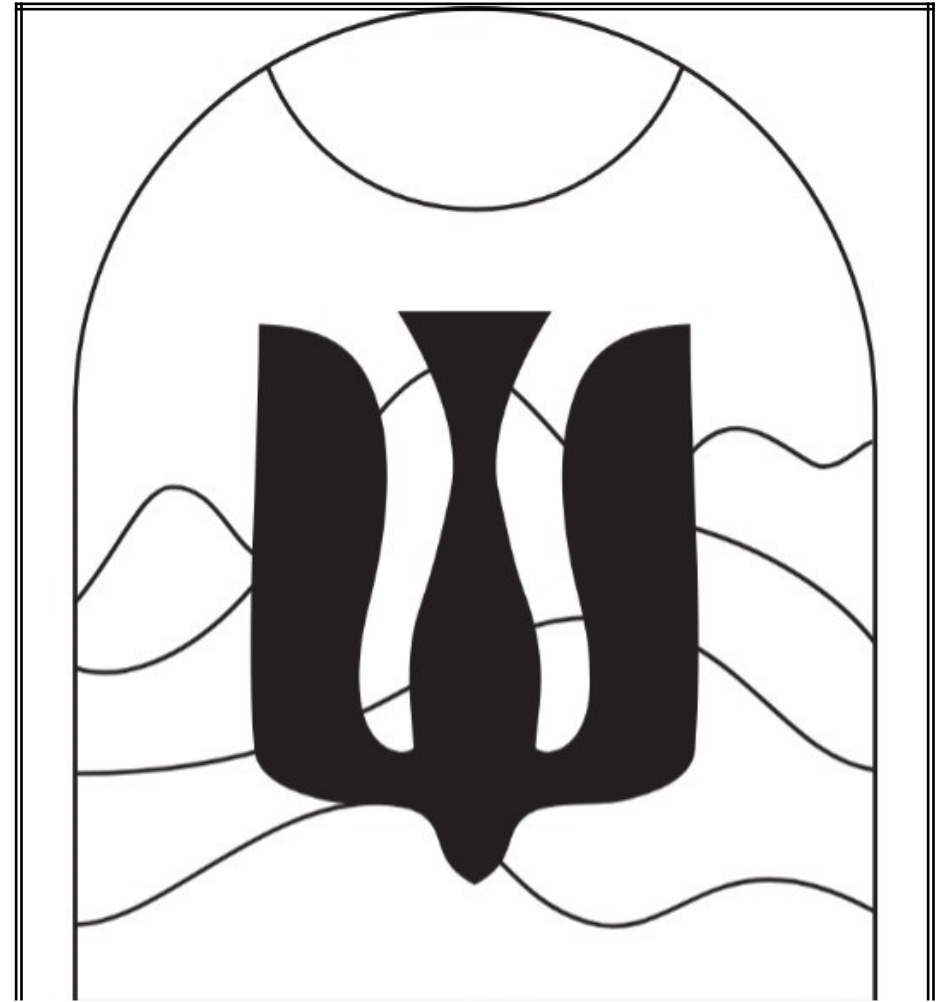
WELCOME
