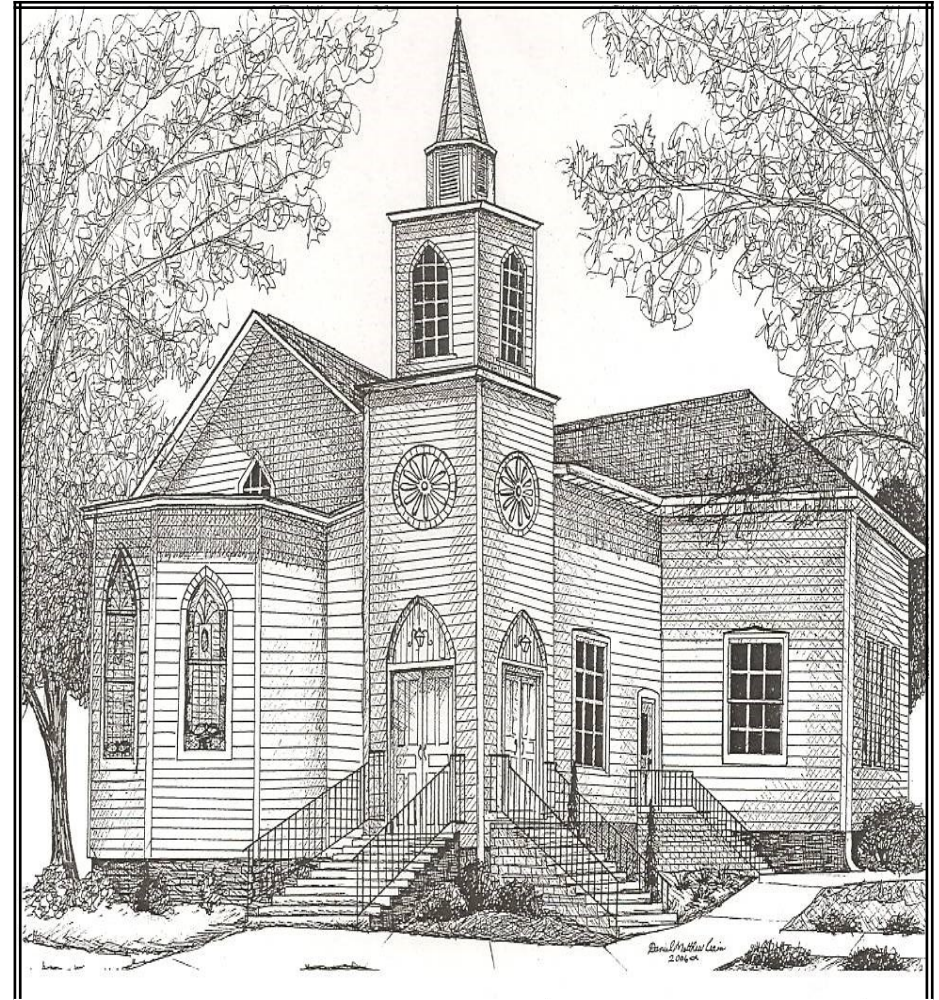
CONGREGATIONAL MEETING
