An honorarium has been given in honor of Nita McMillan in gratitude for all that she does for our church.

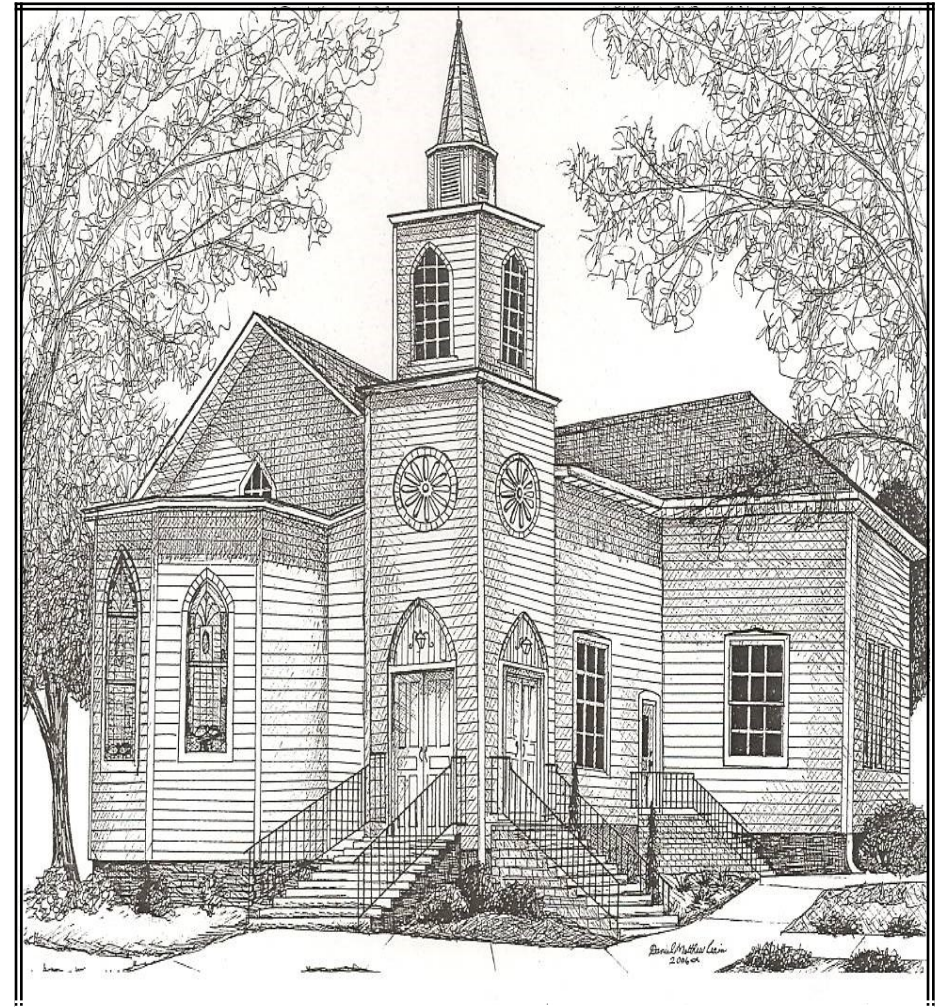
