We pray in the name of the risen Christ. Amen.*

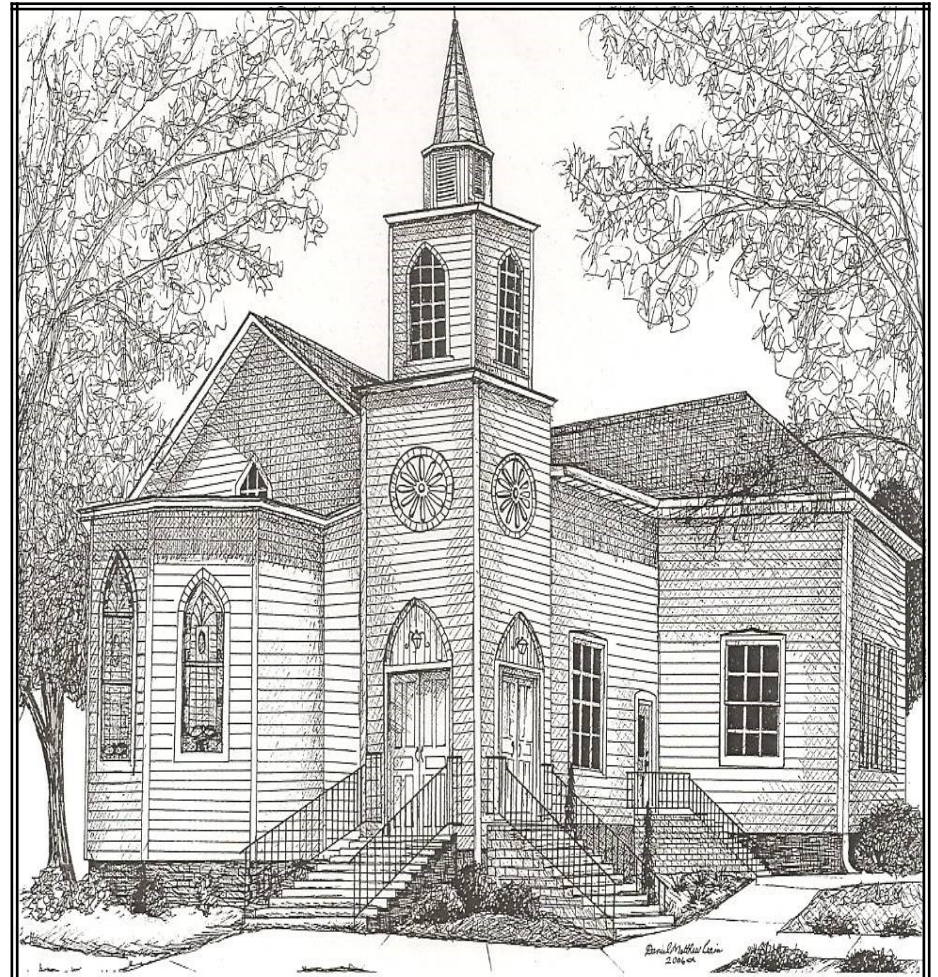
