UPCOMING SERMON

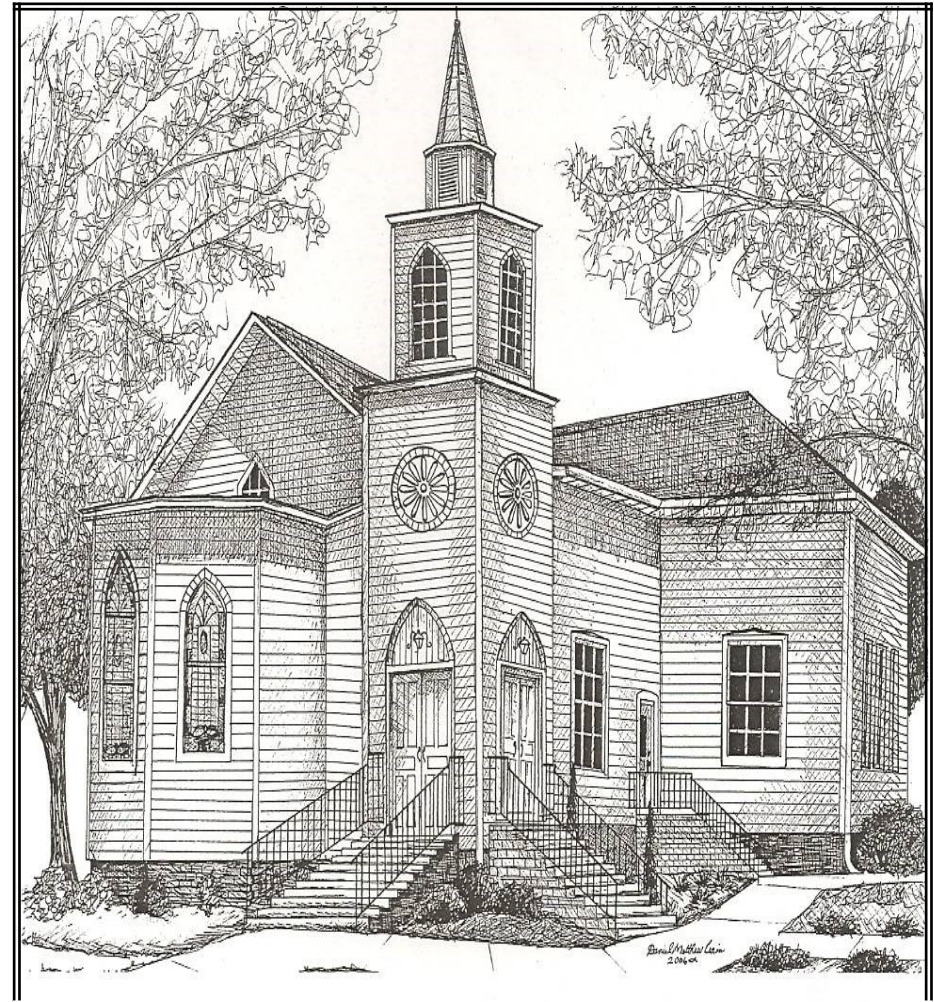
Next Sunday, April 18th, we welcome Art Williams in leading us in worship. Bring a friend or friends to join us and share our Facebook page with them as well!
