Session will meet this afternoon after the congregational meeting in Gossett Hall for our regular stated meeting.

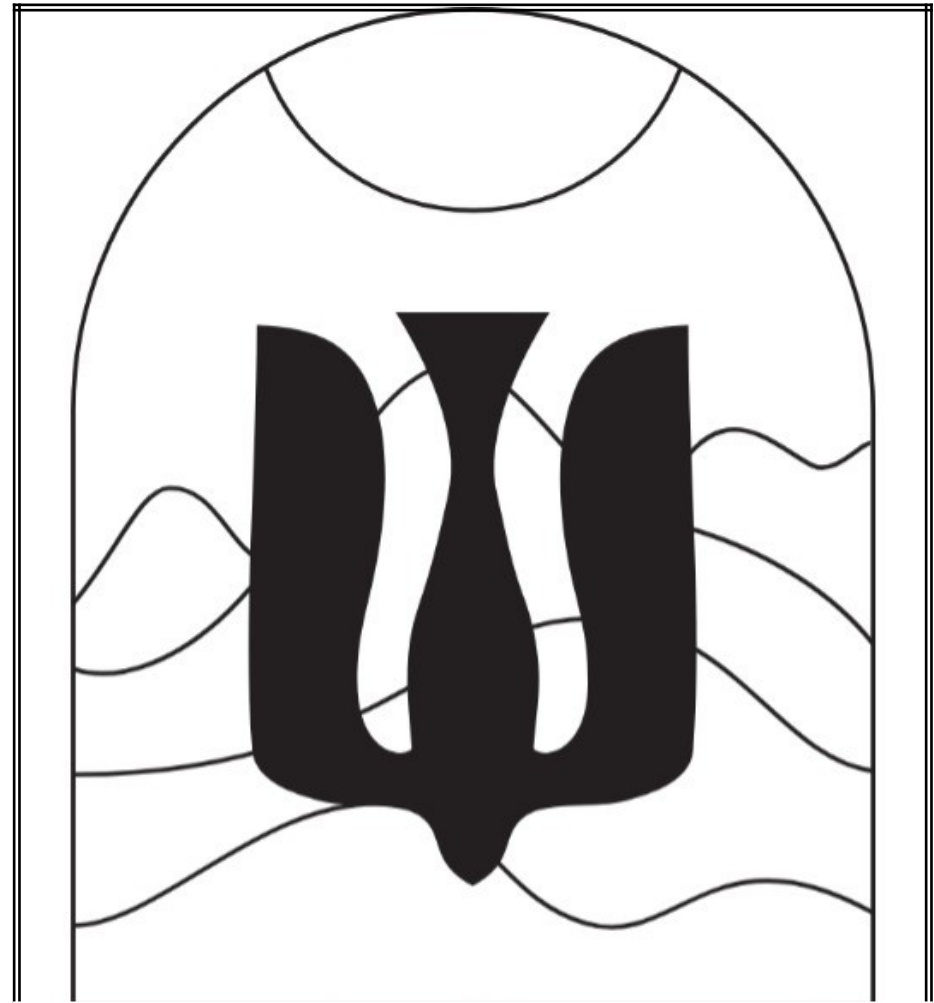
PRESBYTERIAN WOMEN
