PACK A PURSE

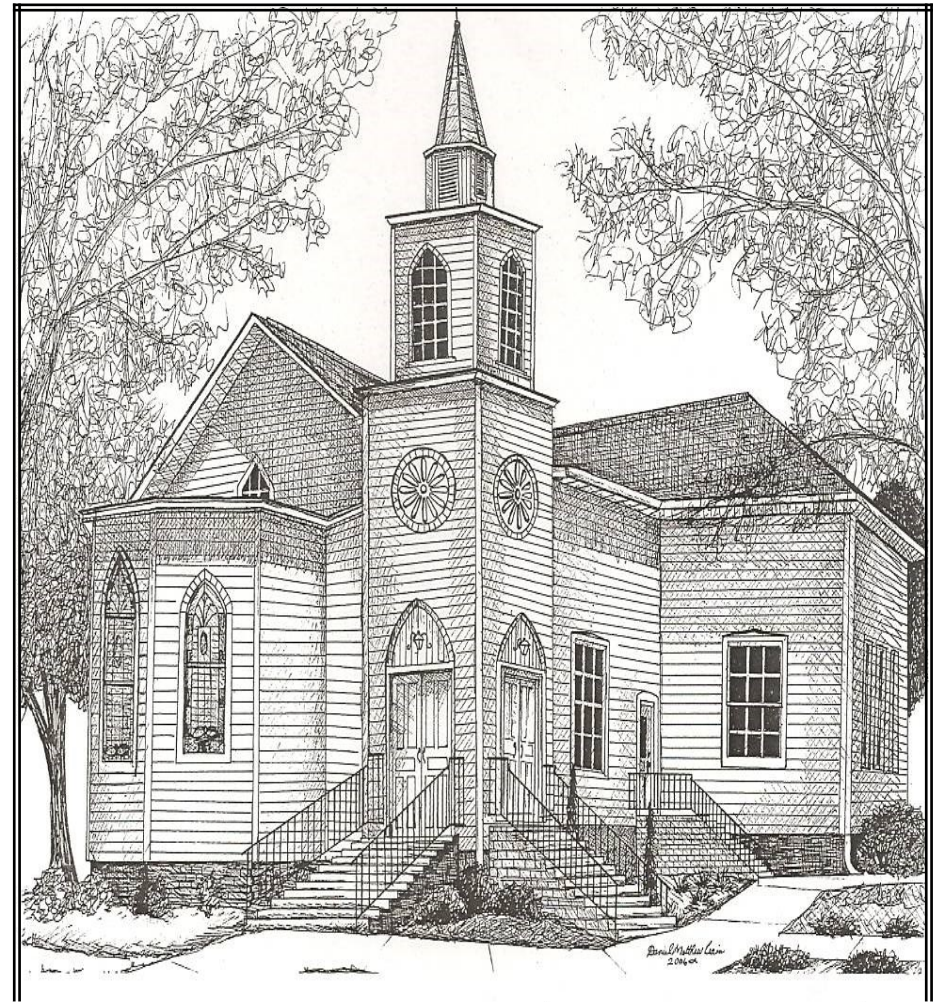
