September Expense: \$11,469.71 \$117,525.03

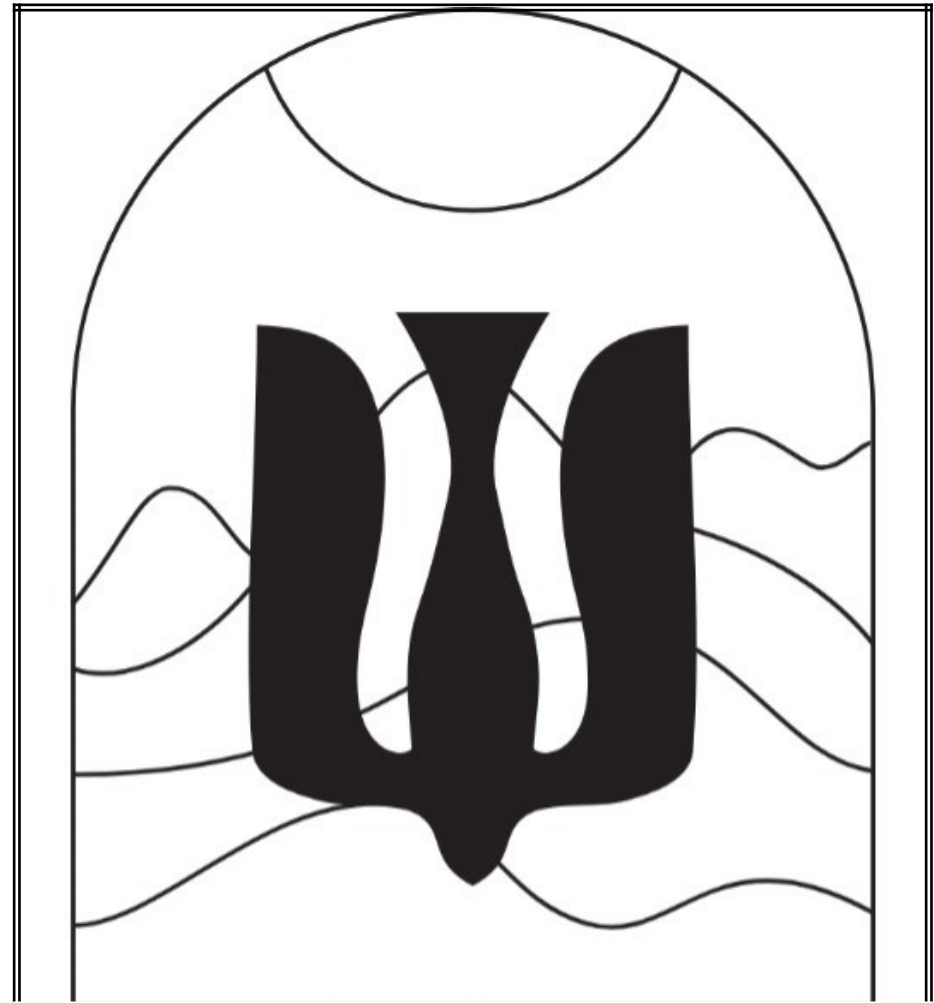
Over/Under: +\$7,228.10 +\$4,516.55
