We will meet in Gossett Hall at 4:30 pm tomorrow for Circle. All women are welcomed and encouraged to attend.

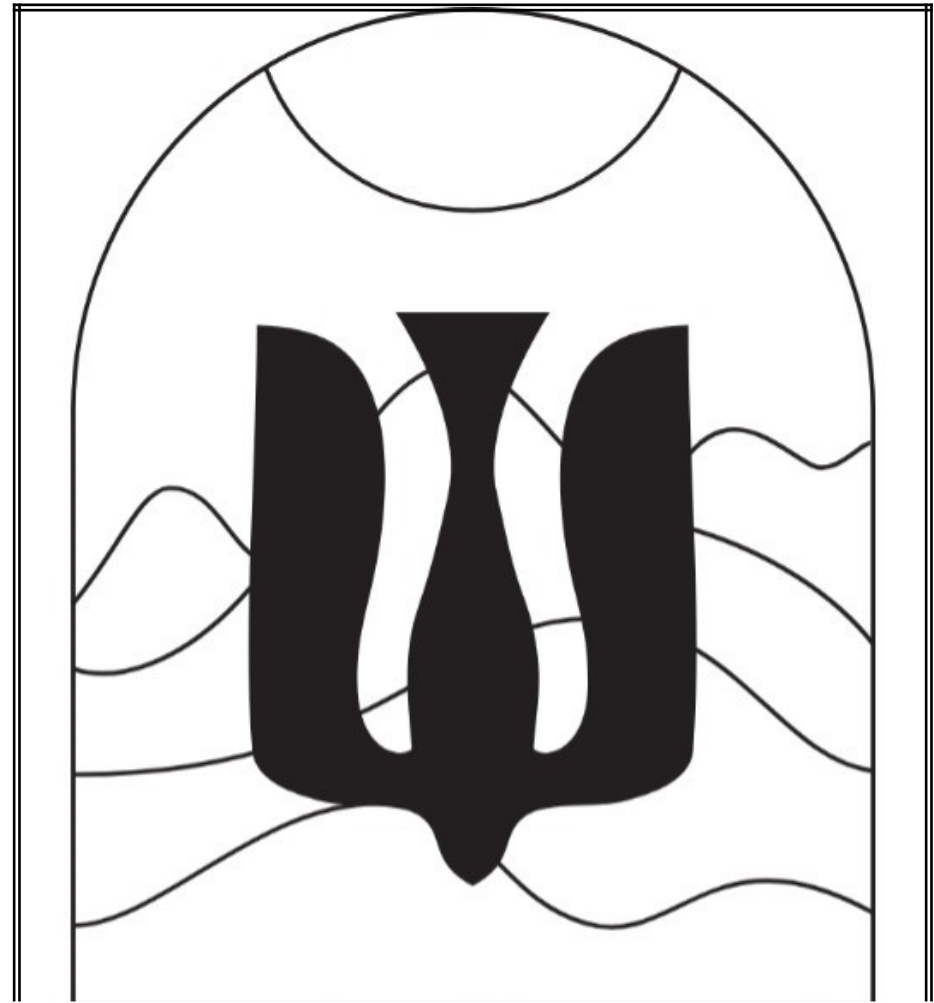
WEEKLY SUNDAY SCHOOL!
