5TH SUNDAY CELEBRATION

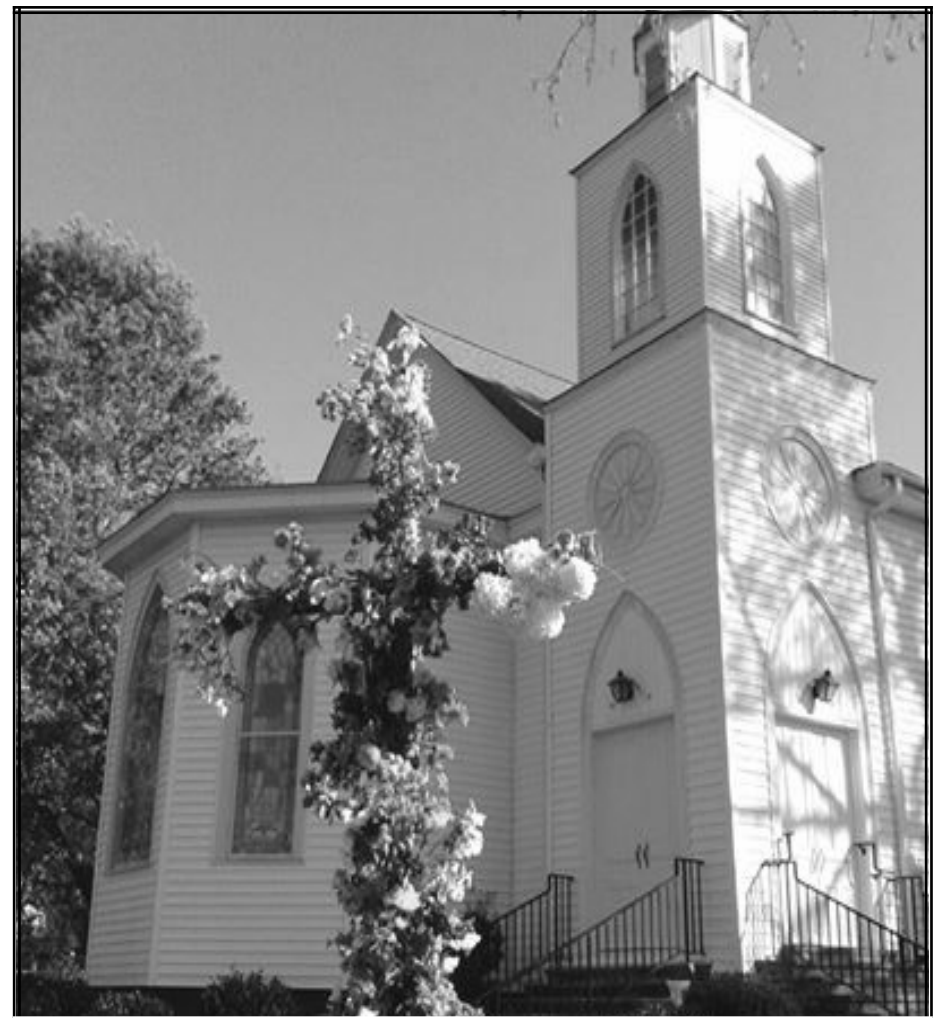
