PENTECOST LUNCHEON

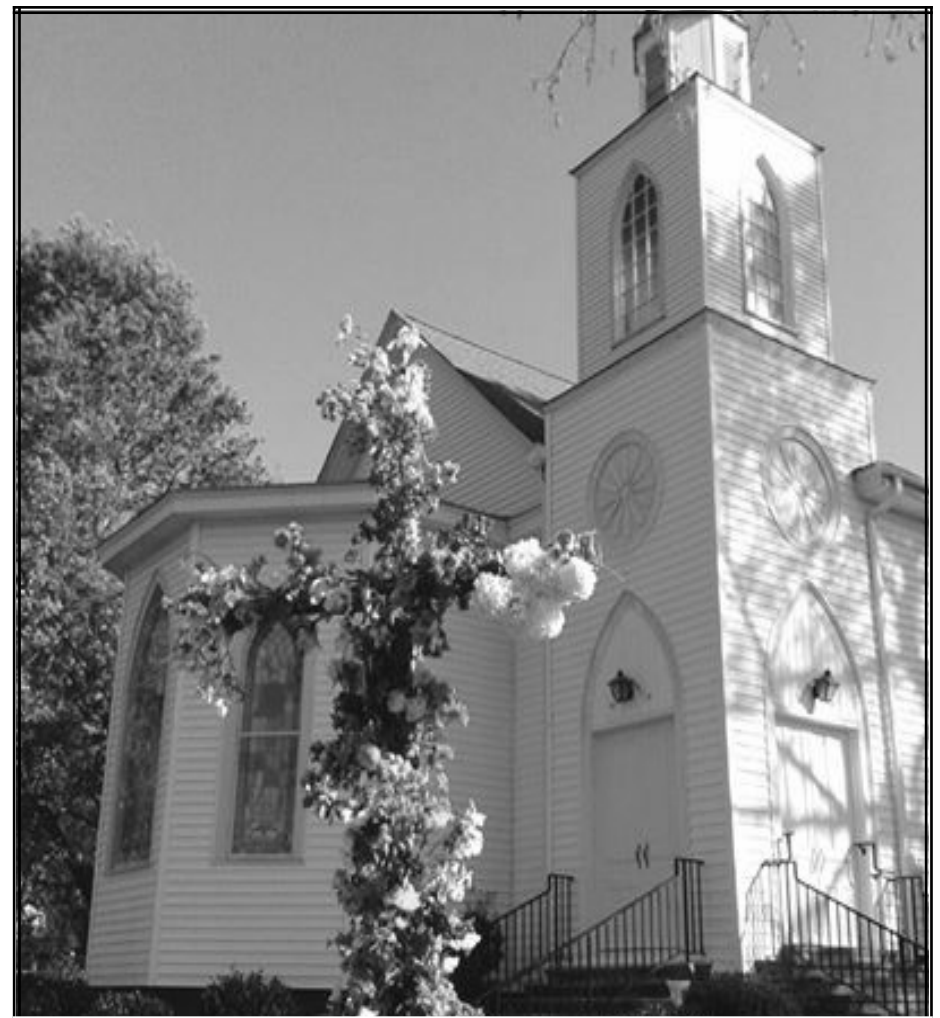
Save the date for our annual Pentecost luncheon on **May 24th** following worship! Don't forget to wear your RED!
