ADULT SUNDAY SCHOOL

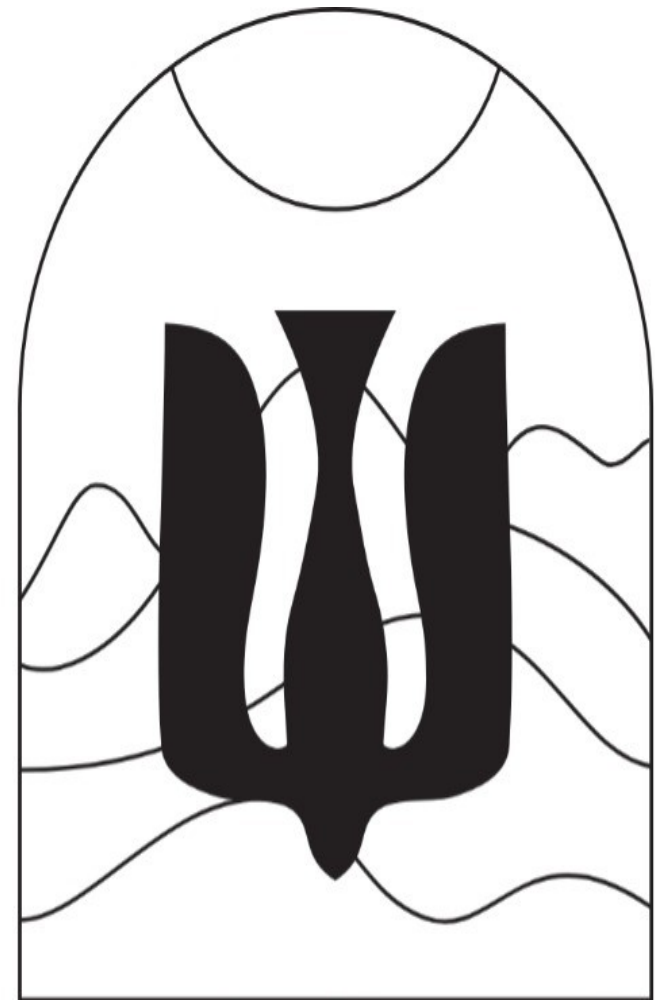
